AUR20720 Certificate II in Automotive **Vocational Preparation**

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge to perform tasks related to identifying and inspecting mechanical and electrical components of:

- light vehicles
- motorcycles.

BSB10120 Certificate I in Workplace Skills

This qualification provides skills and knowledge for those preparing to enter the workforce. You will work on developing the necessary skills in preparation for work. You will work towards skills and knowledge to gain an understanding of the business environment.

FSK20119 Certificate II in Skills for Work & **Vocational Pathways**

This qualification is designed for learners who require further skills

development to prepare for workforce entry or vocational training

pathways.

CHC22015 Certificate II in Community Services (Focus on Children)

This qualification may be used as a pathway for workforce entry as community services workers who provide a first point of contact and assist individuals in meeting their immediate needs.

CHC22015 Certificate II in Community Services (Health Focus)

This qualification would suit someone wishing to work in, and progress to, a career in the health services industry. This qualification provides skills and knowledge for work in a variety of health settings.

CPC20120 Certificate II in Construction

This qualification provides an occupational outcome and a range of support tasks applicable to the majority of construction work sites.

CPC20220 Certificate II in Construction **Pathwavs**

This qualification provides a pathway to the primary trades in the construction industry with the exception of plumbing. Trade outcomes are predominantly achieved through an Australian Apprenticeship and this qualification allows for inclusion of skills suited for entry to offsite occupations, such as joinery as well as carpentry, bricklaying and other occupations in general construction.

UEE22020 Certificate II in Electrotechnology (Career Start) (SoA)

his qualification provides skills and knowledge for work in any electrotechnology discipline. It provides grounding for safety as wellT as other basic skills.

SIS10122 Certificate I in Sport and Recreation This qualification provides the skills and knowledge to prepare for work in the sport and recreation industry. It may lead to further training.

SIS20122 Certificate II in Sport and Recreation (SoA)

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge to work in customer contact positions in the sport or community recreation industry. With this role, you would do tasks using practical skills and basic industry knowledge.

SHB20121 Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge to sell and demonstrate cosmetic products. With this qualification, you could work in a beauty and hairdressing salon or a retail outlet.

SIT20122 Certificate II in Tourism (SoA)

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge to work in the tourism industry. Students will work to achieve a limited range of tourism operational skills and basic industry knowledge. Work could be undertaken in an office environment where the planning of tourism and travel products and services takes place, in the field where products are delivered, or a combination of both.

SIT20322 Certificate II in Hospitality

This qualification provides a pathway to work in various hospitality settings, such as restaurants, hotels, motels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafés, and coffee shops.

SIT20421 Certificate II in Cookery

This qualification provides a pathway to work in kitchen operations in organisations such as restaurants, hotels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafés, and coffee shops; and institutions such as aged care facilities, hospitals, prisons, and schools.

SIS20419 Certificate II in Outdoor Recreation

This qualification provides skills and knowledge to assist with the delivery of recreational activities.
