Exposure to real-world skills in global diplomacy and connections with a network of young changemakers worldwide.

Before the AFS Youth Assembly, dive into a 3-day immersion into global diplomacy, meeting diplomats and experts, and learn how policy shapes the world we live in.

About you

You're a local student heading into Year 12 in 2026 who:

- Has strong academic performance and attendance.
- Enrolled in a HaSS subject in 2025 or 2026 debating or public speaking skills are a bonus!
- Is passionate about global issues, leadership, and social change.
- Is ready to represent Tasmania on the global stage and help your local community on return.



How the selection process works

It's a two-step competitive process in Term 1, 2026:

- 1. Submit a written Expression of interest (EOI) to get shortlisted.
- 2. If you make the cut, you'll need to ace the interview for a place.

More details (including how to apply) will drop in early Term 1, 2026, so stay tuned!

The two-step (EOI and participant selection process) is solely managed by DECYP (participating Colleges and Education International). Once you're offered a place in the Tasmanian delegation, comprehensive information will be shared about delegate registration requirements.

When, where and costs

- Mid-August 2026
- Geneva, Switzerland (hotel accommodation TBC)
- Costs: Program participation costs covered DECYP.
- Your part: Return airfare to Geneva + some meals (capped at \$4,500 per student).
- Extras you'll need to consider: Passport, visas (if needed), travel insurance & spending money.
