What is ConnECT?

ConnECT is a three-day program for Year 10 students entering Year 11 at Elizabeth College in 2025 (Year 12 students new to the college are also invited). During ConnECT you will participate in introductory lessons in your chosen subjects, Enrichment activities, become orientated with the campus and facilities, meet staff and hear about the various programs and opportunities on offer here at Elizabeth College. It will also be an opportunity to make new friends and experience College life.

When is ConnECT?

ConnECT is happening in week 8 of this term, Monday 2- Wednesday 4 December. Classes will run from 8.30am to 3.00pm. Although it won't fully replicate a regular three days at Elizabeth College, it will give you a feel for your subjects, the campus and the opportunities available to you.

What will I be doing during ConnECT?

- Introductory lessons for all your classes
- Finding out about course content and assessment
- Getting a feel for the campus and facilities
- Meeting key staff
- Hearing more about and participating in our Enrichment program
- Participating in other fun activities, information sessions, and skill building opportunities
- Meeting and hearing from some Year 12 students who will share insight into subjects and College life

What do I wear?

Casual clothes. Something that is appropriate for school and practical for moving around a busy campus. Please wear enclosed shoes if you are studying any subjects in the Science, HPE or Technology areas.

Where do I need to go on the first day?

Please arrive ready for an 8.30am start on Monday 2 December and head to the gym for a quick assembly and timetable collection. Don't worry, there will be guides to help you find your way if you are not sure where to go.

What do I need to bring?

- A bag and something to eat and drink for recess and lunch. Our Canteen will also be open if you would like to purchase food. Some snacks will be available and a BBQ is provided on the first day. Breakfast Club daily, 8.00am-8.30am
- If you have a laptop/tablet and charger, please bring
- Pen and paper

Will I be able to leave campus during the day?

You will be required to stay on campus until 3.00pm each day unless a parent/carer is collecting you.

Do I need to attend the full week?

We strongly encourage you to attend for the full program, so that you can 'connect' and feel set up and ready for Year 11, however, if you can only attend one or two days that is better than not at all.
