STEPS FOR YEAR 10 TO 11 ENROLMENT IN 2026

Students from Hobart City and Taroona High Schools are counselled by Elizabeth College teachers during 2026 as part of our Transition Program.

Students from other schools will have opportunities to tour the college, attend our Transition Day and Information Evening, meet with key staff including our Careers Counsellor, Support Teachers and College Course Counsellors prior to enrolment sessions in Term 3 and 4.

ENROLMENT PROCESS

All students will complete their enrolment during August/September 2026. Students are required to bring a copy of their grade 10 mid-year report with them to the enrolment session.

Students from Hobart City and Taroona High Schools who have completed a VET Expression of Interest will be advised about VET suitability processes. All other students who wish to enrol in a VET program will be required to complete VET suitability processes at the time of enrolment.
